

## What is a Home Front Prayer Leader?

This is a volunteer who feels called to pray fervently for others for specified periods of time.

## What would I need to do?

- We ask our volunteers to recruit 2-4 other praying people to commit to praying with them. These might be from your church or Bible Study or neighbors and friends that you pray with.
- Your prayer group would then be assigned one of our traveling mission teams to cover in prayer for the duration of their preparation time, time on the field, and a few days of 'rear guard' praying when they return home. This is on average 6-10 weeks depending on the team.
- You and your team members would pray daily at home for the team's requests.
- Once a week you would meet with your team members to pray together during the assigned time.
- In the event of a crisis prayer request from the field, you would be notified by the World Intercessors prayer team leader of the special prayer request so that you and your team could pray immediately for that request.
- Your team might also be asked to pray for a specific mission field or country during a time when extra prayer is needed for that area or group of missionaries.
- Each prayer assignment is for a specific amount of time. This allows you and your group to rest in between assignments.

## Who will help train and guide me in this volunteer role?

You would meet with one of our World Intercessors. She will offer instructions, guidance, and prayer support to you. She will provide you with needed prayer materials and information from the team leader. When the team you are covering in prayer is in the field. At the end, she will meet with you for a prayer wrap up session.
